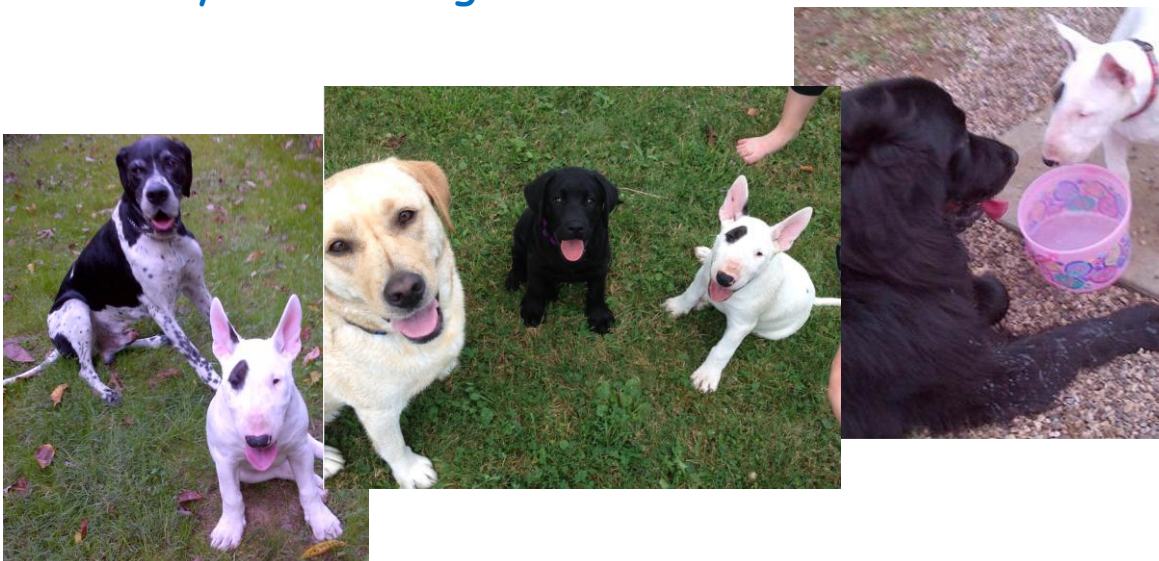


If you live in Granville, you have probably seen me. I like places where there are lots of people and dogs. I socialize at the Farmers' Market on Saturdays; I
